Reasons for approval:

The submitted Flood Risk Assessment concludes that plots 5 and 6 have less than a 0.1% annual probability of flooding. The Council's Sustainability Officer has reviewed the Flood Risk Assessment and confirms that conditions 35 and 34 can be discharged. The details would reduce the rate of surface water runoff from the buildings and limit the impact of storm-water drainage system.

The full impact of the scheme has already been assessed.

The details are thus in accordance with policy CC1 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
