


Dear Mr Dempsey and Camden Planning Office,

Dear Mr Dempsey and the Camden Planning Office,

I refer to the above Planning Application in respect of 7 Rosecroft Avenue, London NW3 7QA and write to lodge an Objection.

My wife and I and family are the owners and occupiers of the house situate at 17 Hollycroft Avenue, Hampstead, NW3 7QH. Our house and garden are overlooked by properties in Rosecroft Avenue including 7 Rosecroft Avenue.

The above-mentioned Planning Application includes a new Dormer Window which we object to. Dormer windows are not in accordance with the Conservation Area. The particular Dormer Window (the subject of the above planning application) unreasonably increases the extent to which our house and garden are overlooked and is unsightly.

I add that that our garden also abuts the garden of 7 Rosecroft Avenue where an oversized garden shed has been built which obscures the entry of light into our garden and is unsightly. We question whether the shed has been built in accordance with planning requirements and request that the compliance of the construction with planning requirements is investigated by the relevant planning officer.
