Proposed pavings to replace existing – with methodology statement – To be read in conjunction with submitted drawings

Product	Location	Size	Product image
Gris limestone brick pavers	Basement level – lightwell See drawings for details	200 x 50 x 20mm	
Description	Natural stone slim brick pavers with light clay grey powder tones and textured erosion to the surface creating an authentic, aged patina.		
Installation methodology	To create a sound, reinforced concrete base then paving the lightwell using Gris limestone brick pavers. The pavers are to be laid in a herringbone style on an even bed of wet mortar and be butt jointed. Kiln dried sand is to be swept into the joints.

Grand provence antiqued limestone	Ground level – Garden See drawings for details	Varying size x 30mm	
Description	Reclaimed limestones found in Southern France, with the time-worn surface texture and patina found on ancient, historic flagstones. The Grand provence pattern features large format stones up to 140x70cm in size and is also calibrated to 30mm thickness giving the advantage of being used outside as well as inside. This is a hand-finished product.		
Installation methodology	To create a sound, compacted sub base of type 1 MOT then pave the back garden using Grand Provence antiqued limestone. The paving is to be laid on an even bed of wet mortar and pointed up with mortar.
