You will develop, deliver and sell high quality consultancy services to businesses in Camden while designing programmes that transfer value from the business sector to community groups in Camden to drive environmental improvement

You will source grant funding for business focused sustainability and air quality projects for delivery under the Camden Climate Alliance brand.

You will manage and review the need for an Alliance Advisory Board and represent the Alliance on internal and external boards and technical advisory groups and always be prepared to present the work of the Alliance at public events.

You will lead the delivery of the Camden's Climate Alliance's GLA funded Business Climate Challenge project. The Business Climate Challenge project involves working with Business Improvement Districts to support 50 businesses to deliver on the recommendations of their recent energy audits.

You will also oversee the delivery of a new "Climate Connectors" project which will match businesses with community groups and schools to direct private investment towards local environmental projects.
