9) TEMPORARY WORKS

The Contractor is responsible for the design, installation and maintenance of all necessary temporary works to ensure the strength and stability of the building throughout the course of the works. All temporary works shown are indicative only.

The contractor shall be responsible for ensuring that sufficient tolerances are provided and integrated throughout all elements of the works.

When installing beams into an opening wider than 3m in an existing structure, allow for the use of folding wedges, Harjaks or other means to pre-deflect the beam to give a mid-span deflection of span/400 before transferring load from temporary works into the beam.

The existing structural information shown on these drawings is based on visual inspection of the building and upon limited opening up works. All details of the existing construction are subject to confirmation by the Contractor during the works on site. No materials are to be ordered until the relevant details and conditions are confirmed by the Contractor on site.

Use figured dimensions only: Do not scale from drawing. All levels and dimensions are to be checked on site. This drawing is to be read in conjunction with all relevant documents
