Subject: Objection re Tree Works at 67 Greencroft Gardens NW6 3LJ

Dear Sir/Madam,

I strongly object to the application (reference: 2023/1157/T) to completely fell three trees at 67 Greencroft Gardens, NW6 3LJ because:

- 1) the trees add (visual) amenity to all of us living in this Conservation Area and enhance our quality of life;
- 2) the trees in this Conservation Area enhance the area's natural biodiversity...for example, I've often heard woodpeckers in these trees (have you checked whether these trees are home to such birds?);
- 3) trees add sequester carbon (and help Camden's climate change targets);
- 4) allowing a TPO to be sidestepped can only encourage other house owners in this Conservation Area to follow suit;
- 5) tree pruning (rather than felling) would avoid all these aforementioned problems.

I hope you will reject the application.
