We are concerned about the removal of the trees for the purposes of construction. These well established trees provide habitat for birds, insects and act as visual barrier between properties. If these are removed for construction at 26 Netherhall Gardens, then several new tall well established trees must be planted (not young saplings that take decades to grow, but already tall trees). In light of the layout of the proposed development with several terraces at the height of or above our garages, it is even more important for the development at 26 Netherhall Gardens to plant a visual wall made of tall well established trees to conceal the privacy of our windows and our lawn and the development's tenants from our view.</p> <p>We are also concerned about the quality of the retention wall between our properties.
