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Objection

Comments

- a) The snug façade design should be <u>subservient</u> to the main house however glazing over the door to the side lobby means it is not and should be removed. It is also very out of keeping with the estate.
- b) As drawn the new window at the front for the snug appears to have wider mullions than the original house and thus wouldn't match.
- c) The skylight for the snug is indicated as being above the height of the parapet and will be easily visible to passers-by. A shallower version that keeps below the height of the old garage parapet would be less obtrusive.
- d) A north/south section through the snug (in addition to the passageway) would be helpful.
