Please identify the tree(s) and provide a full and clear specification of the works you want to carry out
I have been approached by the resident at 14 Doynton Road to prune the overhanging branches of their neighbours self-seeded Fraxinus
excelsior. This tree (which lies on council property at number 12) is overhanging my clients property and is preventing the gutters from working properly, resulting in water ingress to my clients property. When in leaf this is even worse. The overhanging branches have also damaged the
guttering, and in windy weather is banging on my clients roof. This self sown tree appears to be growing dangerously close to the
neighbouring property and the council have been informed but no action has been taken. The client would like me to remove all the offending branches overhanging her property and causing damage to her house and gutters.
The tree itself is about 10-15m high, with a span of about 8m. We wish to cut off several branches overhanging my clients property at and

The tree itself is about 10-15m high, with a span of about 8m. We wish to cut off several branches overhanging my clients property at and above roof height, each branch being 2-3.5m in length. Ideally the whole tree needs removing before it causes any more structural damage but neither my client or her neighbour can fund this.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
