Then, at some point a few years ago, without my knowledge, extractor fans were installed interfering with the view and generating considerable noise.</p> <p>At a later date I think, a wall was actually installed which eliminated the view completely.</p> <p>I am deeply unhappy with the current state of affairs and actually in the process of trying to get the existing extractors removed as they seem to have been redundant for some time.</p> <p>Would I ever approve additional extractors / noise? The answer is a flat NO!
