While we are in no way opposed to the general application, we do however feel that the side dormer might be a step too far given how close the two properties are to each other and the direct visual access which would be created to the kitchen of flat 3 and to the bedroom of flat 4 which would very likely lead to a loss of privacy as mentioned in our initial comments. We ask that you consider carefully the possible negative impacts of a side dormer on the neighbours of an adjacent property in such close proximity and, that before a decision on this made, the applicant should be able to demonstrate that in accordance with planning guidance the new dormer will not cause the neighbouring residents at 15 to suffer a significant loss of light or privacy or overlooking as a consequence, and that there is no alternative configuration which could lessen these possible impacts. It is also worth noting that, as there is already a window in the roof at 17 which causes none of these issues, is the addition of a side dormer really necessary or justifiable? Our feeling is that it could potentially be both intrusive and obtrusive and we hope that you will take our concerns into account.
