T2) Lime on front boundary: Semi-mature tree has been pollarded several time due to close proximity to the building (1.5 metres) and persistent damage to brick work of perimeter wall. Wrong species for this location considering vigorous regrowth and potential height and spread. The immediate surrounding area has dense vegetation and foliage cover.

T3) Sweet Chestnut in rear garden area:
