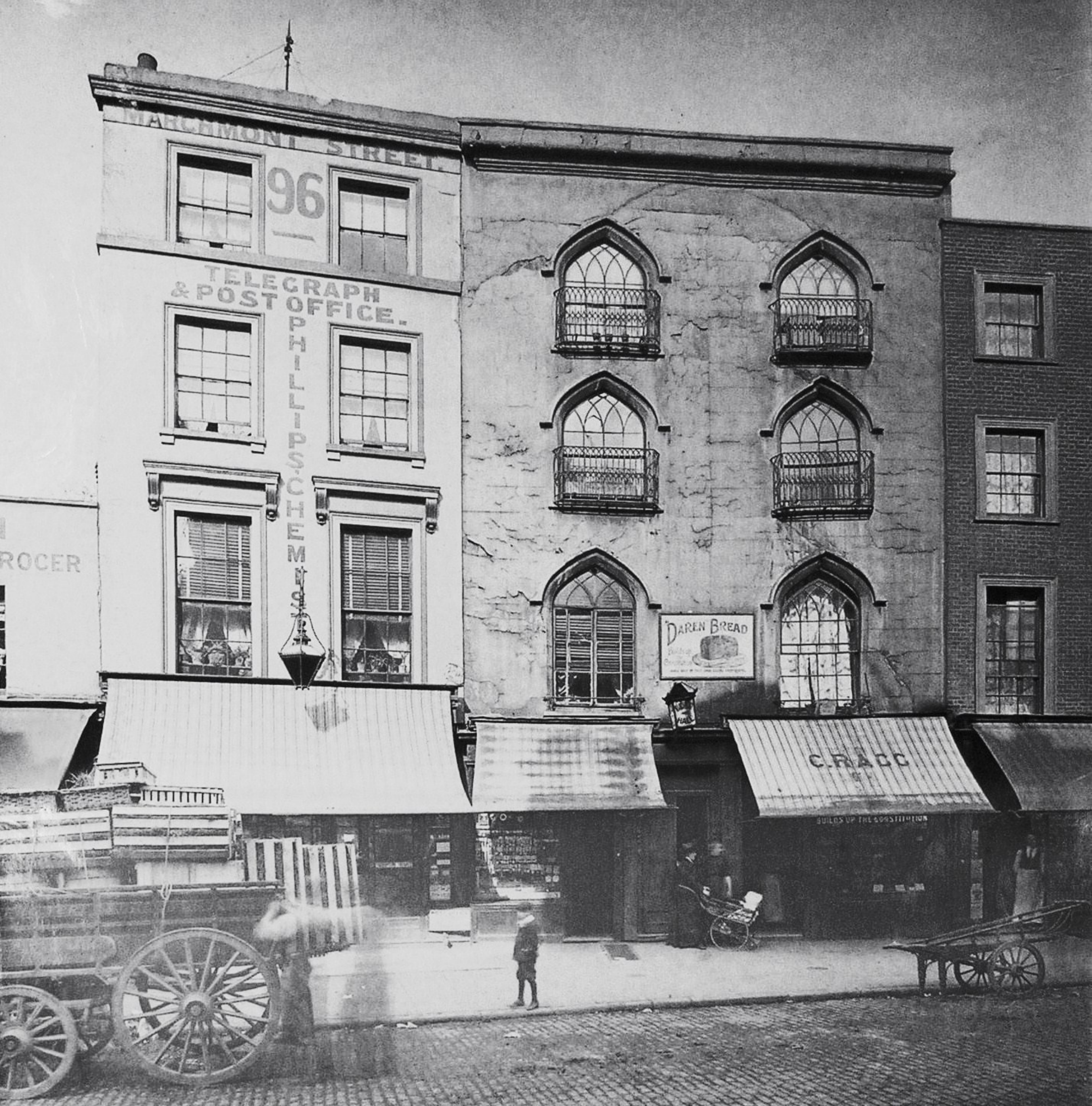
I hope this is helpful to you in your deliberations.
