Its unbearable in the summer with large groups gathering in the garden shouting and screaming all night, they can carry on well past closing time. We have a bedroom at the back of the house along with many other residents.</p> <p>I have lived here for many years and have been shocked at the amount of planning permission that has been granted to make the back of these properties bigger and unsightly, taking all the [REDACTED] and peace away from the current residents that live here.</p> <p>The people that already live and work in this area are already are struggling with antisocial behavior due to buildings being extended and outside living spaces being created in area that really doesn't have any more space. I can hear the tv with my windows closed from the extended building at the back of my house its so close. The music and late nights we have to suffer from the balcony areas has been very exhausting for us.</p> <p>If you create a balcony area no matter who is living in the property it will be used and the most popular reason seems to be phone calls on speaker phone and smoking or parties, can be all three together too. I have complained many times to the council but this seems to be a hard thing for them to control. So why would we build more extensions so more noise and [REDACTED] can be taken away from decent people just wanting to sleep in their beds at night, or does this no longer matter.</p> <p>This is not the first time this property has requested planning permission. Permission was requested in August last year and was declined (2022/2687/P). The new planning is even worse than the last one as it now has four new outdoor spaces so four times more noise for residents to suffer. When we are too sick to go to work from stress or too tired due to lack of sleep can we contact you to resolve the issue and if not, who will take the responsibility I wonder.</p> <p>We will also have to suffer many months of building work noise thats has previously been a problem as this tends to start very early 7 days a week and end very late. Even though restrictions are meant to be in place they are never followed.</p> <p>I disagree with this extension and I would hope that you would consider the people who live here and their [REDACTED]. We should be able to have some [REDACTED] rather than buildings being so close together that you have to keep your curtains closed as people are [REDACTED] all hours, and to sleep in our homes without constant noise and that has been forced upon us from planning permission being granted with no thought for other residents.</p>
