Details of representation

The application states that the premises are in a commercial/shopping area. This is somewhat disingenious. The premises are situated within the Bloomsbury Conservation Area and border Bury Place, Bloomsbury Square , Little Russell Street, Great Russell Street and Museum Street. There are well over 150 residential properties within this area cobnsisting of Mansion Block apartments and street



properties and are occupied by a mixed diverse vibrant community. The applicant has applied for opening hours up until 4am. We believe this will have a detrimental impact upon the community and will encourage the gathering of people returning from late night west end clubs looking for fast food outlets., This in turn could lead to anti social behaviour, and further disorder in the early hours of the morning in an area where residents already have to put up with rickshaw disturbance and late night revellers trying to return to their homes. The addition of a fast food outlet so close to a densely populated area with very late opening hours can only lead to an increase in noise disturbance, additional litter and general public nuisance in the immediate and surrounding area. For these reasons we strongly advise the Licensing Authority to reject this application.
