Please identify the tree(s) and provide a full and clear specification of the works you want to carry out
(T1) False Acacia - Fell to ground level & remove stump via grinding. The tree had a limb split our in 2019 across the road and hit a car. In early 2020 my client had a tree survey taken of the false acacia and it was deemed as a significant risk due to losing half of its crown and leaning heavily towards number 257 Goldhurst terrace. It has also caused the pavement to raise which is a trip hazard & pushing the brickwall slightly into the public pavement. There is also a new build taking place next door so my client is quite worried about a. his property if the tree was to decide to shed another limb & b. the danger to this new build.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

My client is wanting to replant with a prunus tree of some kind, more than likely a cherry.
