Along the way, as with most sectors she realised how white washed the period activism space was and wanted to challenge that - so she launched Proud of My Period to openly discuss her work and what she was learning about periods.

She was featured on a Newsround special on periods in her own segment 'Top tips for feeling confident about periods' and she worked as the inclusion consultant for the Cycle by Freda by McCann Madrid campaign.

Kasey is the Learning Development Lead for Bloody Good Employers and designed the three-module program. She has continued to work alongside BGE in order to see her hard work in action and is incredibly thrilled with the reaction and impact BGE workshops have had on partners and participants already.
