The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed ASHP in the front lightwell and associated works to the front facade, by reason of the introduction of visual clutter to a historic façade and the failure to demonstrate there would be no harm to historic fabric, would result in 'less than substantial' harm to the special interest of the listed building and the character and appearance of the conservation area as designated heritage assets, which is not outweighed by public benefits, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
