I am the Youth Services Manager writing on behalf of [Queen's Crescent Community Association](#)'s Youth Advisory Board, The Dome Action Team with reference to LabTech's planning application (ref.2022/3853/P) which relates to Camden Lock Market and the development of new exhibition spaces, installation of new retail shop fronts within West Yard, opening up of Dead Dog Basin and the erection of a temporary observation wheel.

The Action Team are a cohort of seven who are diverse in respect of their age, gender, class and ethnicity and meet a minimum of once a month and ensure young people's ideas shape QCCA's services.

All the members are current attendees at The Dome and live in Camden. DAT members co-design our materials, provide insight into our programmes and actively contribute to our work at all levels including our strategy, resource development and youth service delivery.

They were very inspired by this proposal, particularly around the themes of how the exhibition and retail space will:

- Celebrate Camden's local and forgotten history. They viewed it as a positive community initiatives that has the potential to create healthy and positive sense of local identity and;
- Create dedicated and good quality opportunities for young people from schools and youth organisations to explore Camden's culturally rich history.

I hope their views will be taken into account, as young people are often left out of the conversation when it comes to influencing decisions that happen in their local area.

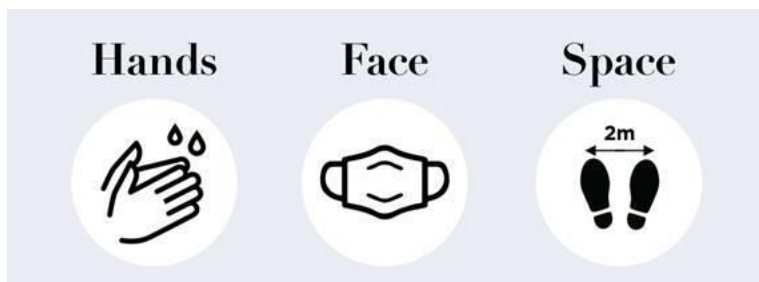
