Dear Camden Planners,

I am writing to object most strongly to the above planning application to erect a forty metre high Ferris wheel in Camden Lock. This extremely ill-advised proposal shows gross insensitivity to the relatively modest scale of the many old buildings in its immediate vicinity, a human scale which gives Camden Lock much of its visual appeal. At forty metres high, it will also degrade the visual environment of the listed buildings and conservation areas of Camden Town as a whole', of which there are a significant number.

I am also very concerned about the impact of yet more visitors in an already congested area. Levels of overcrowding in the Lock are worryingly high, especially at the weekends. In the summer, access to the tube station has had to be restricted to protect the public.

Camden Lock is a site of considerable historical importance. Its industrial archaeology should be respected and preserved for our own and future generations. It should not be treated as the inconvenient background to a fairground attraction.
