My 2 main reasons are:

1. Broxwood Way, used to be a quiet access path/ road, serving local residents of Kingsland Broxwood Way and Avenue Close and St Stephen's Close. It is now extremely congested, with cars and vans and local residents and children struggle to walk up and down safely.
