Fig Tree at 33 Princess

Tree species: Fig tree

The tree was planted in 1965 and is now oversized for the small courtyard garden. The canopy predominantly overhangs the neighbours garden at 31 Edis St, blocking their light.

It also impacts the light and wall of No 29 Edis Street, who have raised concerns about potential subsidence issues.

It remains upright as it's supported by the party wall and is damaging the wall. Even though it is pruned back every couple of years it is difficult to control.

A description of the proposed works:

We would like to replace it with as mature a tree as practicable probably a small fruit tree or Japanese maple. New tree options are specified in PDF document attached to the application.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
