I write on behalf of The Cavendish School in Inverness Street. We are a small primary school that attracts many children from the local area and surrounding neighbourhoods.

Our overriding concerns with the planning application are two-fold:

1) There is a high likelihood that the attraction will attract even more antisocial behaviour than currently takes place in Camden. Our pupils are young and impressionable and it is already hard to shield them from the blatant dealing that takes place in the streets.

2) There is the potential for severe overcrowding of the narrow pavements. Since many of our children walk and to school with their parents, there is the potential for jostling and accidents. The streets of Camden, or more accurately, the pavements, do not have the capacity to contain safely even more visitors than at present.
