
OVERVIEW OF SOFT LANDSCAPING: The soft landscaping has a broader mix of tree, shrub, herbaceous and groundcover, plus a natural grass lawn with shade and drought tolerant grass mix. The additional soft landscaping increases the horticultural mix from pure amenity grass to a richer mix for wildlife habitat. It is informed by policy BGI 1 of the Redington and Frognal Neighbourhood Plan. It builds on and diversifies the mix of existing Sycamore, Chestnut and London Plane trees.
