We have been residents of Camden for 16 years now, living in close proximity to the market. The market has evolved throughout the years, but it has in large part retained its character and kept a strong link to its heritage as a site and community.

We strongly object to the planning application of a ferris wheel in the heart of the market, which is also one of its most scenic locations.

The market and surrounding area is attractions millions of visitors each year, surely there is no need for it to start developing a different type of large attraction to attract even more, putting unsustainable pressure on transport and infrastructure.

Visually the wheel has no connection to the site, and the market itself. More than that, this type of attraction really goes against the alternative / indie concept of the market, by turning it into one more tourist site like thousands of others with generic attractions.

Finally, this tall structure will invade privacy of many local residents, which are already putting up with the crowds and noise levels of the market.
