Bradford Watts have provided a cost of £7,993 + vat for rebuilding and pinning a sample bay and load testing it — see item 6.7 on the attached quote. They also provided a cost for an additional load test. I don't know which company will be undertaking the load test, but the cost is likely to be higher if BW rebuild and pin a bay and we go to a third party testing company, such as Sandberg, to undertake the load test.

The test bay can be an extension of one that was previously deconstructed (it will need to be extended to form a compete bay and pinned) or a new one.
