Thank you for your email and my apologies for the lack of response until now. As the trees are situated within the Regents Park Conservation Area they are afforded legal protection automatically. As such, it is not expedient for The Council to serve TPOs to protect them. If the trees were considered to be at risk, for example if a s.211 notification were to be submitted to fell them, it is then The Council would be considered serving a TPO. This applies to all trees in all conservation areas, not just Regents Park.
