To Whom It May Concern:

I very strongly object to this planning application, for planned developments in Camden Market, including an observation wheel in the Regent's Canal Conservation area.

Camden Market already has 28 million visitors per year, and the proposal to have such a wheel in a confined space, in an area which is already dangerously overcrowded, seems foolhardy in the extreme. Historic England has already objected, and many residents object to a construction which would lead to a loss of privacy.

There would be an increase in noise, litter and anti-social behaviour, which is already at intolerable levels. Crime is commonplace and the crowds make it extremely difficult to police, or for ambulances to get through. There is a lack of adequate toilet facilities for the large crowds, especially on Saturdays and Sundays. Transport to this area is already inadequate and tube platforms and escalators are dangerously overcrowded at weekends.

Unless there is considerable investment in public transport serving this area, <u>before</u> any planned development takes place, there is a real danger of a major disaster.
