GREEN ROOF MAINTENANCE PLAN

The green roof is proposed for the extension roof at Lower Ground Floor level. It will have 100mm of substrate.

Roof Inspection

Inspect the roof at least twice a year for weeds and seeds (carried by the wind) and remove this unwanted vegetation manually. Do this preferably in spring and autumn. To encourage biodiversity, do not use chemical pesticides.

Check whether the drainage system is still functioning properly. Remove any leaves blown into the gutters and drains.

The number of inspections will depend on the greenery in the vicinity of your roof.

Fertilization

Fertilise the green roof twice a year in late April and early September.

<u>Irrigation</u>

A well-rooted green roof requires no additional water. Only under very dry conditions is it necessary to provide the green roof with water. In lengthy dry spell water weekly depending on any Water Company restrictions.
