Hello Elaine

I'm Troy Robertson Johnson from Flat 26, Searle house NW8 7EB. I have lived here since the block was built back in 2014. I am a vulnerable man who is severely disabled and I require 24 hour care. I have a spinal injury and learning disabilities. I need continuous access to my flat as I am in a wheelchair, and unable to walk, and require easy access and working lifts at all times.

I have lived here since Searle House was built and had to live here through the disruption of the work that was done back then to both finish Searle House and through the building of Benjamin House(2 years of hell), with nuisances from dirt, pests and noise etc. I will suffer once again from extensive and prolonged noise disturbances/access problems/disruptions to services and from pests if this proposed development goes ahead.

Should it go ahead, I will have nowhere else to go to escape the situation, as I am paralysed and bed-bound. I also have a lot of expensive property and sensitive electronic medical equipment which is at risk in my flat from dirt and vibration. When scaffolding is put up I will be at risk of being robbed if there is scaffolding outside my property and robbers will have easy access to my flat. I feel my mental health will be severely affected by this lengthy building project.

I am very much against this development proposal. If you wish to discuss this further please contact my mother who can speak to you on my behalf.
