Andrew Wassell has suggested that I write to you as I gather that Ben Galley is now longer with Camden.

In 2016 Ben dealt with tree root damage from a Camden-planted Norway Maple in the pavement outside my driveway, this involved demolishing a low boundary wall and rebuilding this with a 'bridge' lintel over the Maple roots. Camden insurers paid for this work as arranged by Michael Wall (ref 15TR 000009).

Now the roots have invaded my front flower bed and killed a substantial privet hedge. We grubbed up the hedge to reveal the extensive Maple roots - see photos attached. These roots clearly come from the Camden tree and I fear that in time they will cause more damage to our paved driveway beyond the flower bed. So we intend to remove the roots and replant the flower bed.

I shall look forward to your early reply.
