Dear Camden Planning,

I object to the Ferris Wheel at Camden Lock on the basis of:

- a) changing the entire character of the important historical site that is Camden Lock;
- b) the displacement of important birdlife in the vicinity due to noise and nuisance (including a resident Grey heron which is a bird of conservation concern);
- c) the extra tourist numbers which it will attract when already the infrastructure is barely able to cope on busy days; and
- d) The extra congestion around the basin area this will cause and which will be a major public health and safety concern, particularly in the event of an incident (fire, alert of some kind, etc).

I therefore suggest you reject this planning application as it is entirely not in keeping with the area and will cause dangerous overcrowding, amongst the other issues mentioned above.
