Dear Planning Officers,

A a resident in Camden since 1981, and someone who greatly values the unique community spirit of the area as well as its eighteenth- and nineteenth-century architectural inheritance, some of it imaginatively repurposed, may I object in the strongest possible terms to the planning application for a Ferris Wheel (no. 2022/3853P)? This pointless addition would not only be an ugly and unnecessary addition to the skyline, and an inappropriate addition to the Regent's Canal area which is listed and deserves protection; it would bring the Market area further downhill into a repository of litter, mess, aimless drifters and general scruffiness. The argument that this would enhance the area as a tourist destination holds no water at all; and it would be an unwarrantable intrusion into an intensely residential area with many families living in flats and houses around, whose lives would be interfered with by this unlovely and anti-social addition. Please, in the interests of all residents and the traditions and atmosphere of Camden, reject this unacceptable application.
