1 Condition 39 (highways contribution and levels plans) is broken up in two parts,

the first being the confirmation of payment (£210,627.98) towards the highways contribution has been secured, and the second being the submission of a levels plan.

The payment of £210,627.98 was processed on the 23rd of November 2022 under Clause 4.3(1) of the s106 legal agreement. A discharge notice and acknowledgement of payment has been issued by the London Borough of Camden. This has been provided as material evidence of the payment being made.

Council's Sustainability Officer reviewed the submitted levels plan and raised no objections.

The full impact of the development has been considered during the determination of the original application.

As such, the details are in accordance with the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
