Residents at Matilda Apartments have raised objections to this other application. However, I will state the same objections as an individual and as Chair of the Residents Committee at Matilda Apartments.
				Although permission has not yet been granted and comments/objections are still open CSG started to erect the screen on the 14th June. It was completed and started airing TV on 16th June. As the sound of the screen was very intrusive, in my role of Chair of the Residents Committee, I contacted our local councillors who helped with ensuring CSG turned the screen off until the hearing of their application.
				The planning application states that the screen is for 'advertising purposes' but, as they have emailed me to confirm, they intend to show news and sports with volume on from 12pm to 8pm. They emailed me stating 'The screen will play from 8am-8pm however there is no noise from 8-12pm just the news showing, then from 12-8pm the screen will have noiseWe may only screen with noise pre 12pm if it is a special event such as a sporting final etc.'
				When they did volume testing on 16th June, myself and other residents in Matilda Apartments could still hear the sound even though CSG stated 'We have been out several times and the screen volume is very low, you would hear the screen as you would with the outside noise if windows / doors are open especially being in the heart of London.' So even though they state the TV volume will be low, they do acknowledge it will be audible in our homes.
				As these are the summer months, I like to have my windows open. I am working from home. If the screen has sound playing it is like having someone else's television on in my flat. This is annoying and disturbing. In a work Zoom meeting today, a patient asked if I had a TV on, I had to close my windows to stop the noise from the screen in the Piazza.
				To summarise: (1) It is unacceptable that residents at Matilda Apartments are to be disturbed by noise from 12pm – 8pm and on some days form 8am-8pm (2) It is unacceptable that I and my neighbours cannot enjoy our homes or work from home, without closing windows during the hottest part of the year, from now until September, because of commercial noise pollution (3) CSG misled in their planning application by stating the screen was for advertising, when it is going to be used for showing television programs and sports
				Please help residents at Matilda Apartments - at the very least, SCG should not screen with volume that is

audible in any of our homes with windows open.
