La Sainte Union School, entrance at 51-53, Croftdown Road NW5.

I have read the Marcus Foster Arboricultural Survey and Design and also their Management Plan for the 102 trees on the site. I welcome this as a much-needed comprehensive survey, especially as the Health and Safety of the school children, staff and visitors are very important.

They recommend seven Priority works which should be carried out within three months of the report. These include the fellings of the Silver Birch (T2), the Horse Chestnut (T28) and the Larch (T93). Also works the Ash (T5), Cherry (T47), Horse Chestnut (T53) and (T102) Cherry. I do not object to these works. They recommend 44 Moderate Priority works which should be carried out within a year.

(I think that the Cedar (T48) has a TPO served upon it).

They recommend seventeen Low Priority works which should be carried out within three years.

I do not object to these works or to the re-inspection of, and the continued hazard assessment of the trees, as schoolchildren are involved.
