The tree is an Ailanthus which is enclosed by No 37 Cambden Mews. Extensive reaction wood growth in the union between a scaffold limb and the tree's trunk is forcing the limb downwards. In effect the reaction wood is driving a wedge into the union between the branch and the tree. This has resulted in the limb collapsing onto the roof of part of the house causing structural damage to it. It is not clear if the limb would have failed and broken out of the tree if it had not come to rest on the building. The damaged part of the building is to be removed and rebuilt. The limb which has failed is to be propped and the trees crown braced with dynamic rigging. Props are to be supported by helical screw piles inserted into the ground near to the tree's base. Their locations will be informed by a ground radar survey which will be completed by Tree Radar UK Ltd. The objective is to avoid damaging the trees roots, as such the piles will be sited where roots are absent or insignificant. To reduce the tree's canopy weight its crown shall be reduced by 25%. Formative canopy pruning over the next five years is likely to be required if the tree responds by producing multiple suckers at pruning points.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
