Additionally a replacement of a circular window in a basement bedroom and a new wondow in a second basement bedroom. The property is a 2 story flat located on the ground and lower ground floors at the back of 2 terraced houses that have been joined together and divided up into 7 flats. The flat is part of an extension built in the 1970's and has sole ownership of the garden at the rear of the building. The property is not overlooked and backs onto privately owned tennis courts. The proposed development is to make one rectangular window out of two existing round windows in the stairwell of the flat between the ground and lower ground floor to the rear of the property. Additionally a replacement of a circular window in a basement bedroom and a new wondow in a second basement bedroom. This will be done in a similar style to the existing patio doors. The window in the stairwell is behind an existing external staircase. It is not visible from neighboring properties as the building is a basement flat and the window is lower than the next door property. The windows are intended to allow more light into the properties entrance hallway and respective bedrooms. Additionally the windows in the bedrooms will allow airflow into the bedrooms. Currently they only have patio doors which are not left open in the evenings (restricting fresh air).
