Grounds of Appeal

The appellant/s have appealed on the following grounds:

- a) That planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the notice. (X)
- b) That the breach of control alleged in the enforcement notice has not occurred as a matter of fact. ()
- c) That there has not been a breach of planning control. ()
- d) That, at the time the enforcement notice was issued, it was too late to take enforcement action against the matters stated in the notice. ()
