The tower block would be far too high, adversely affect the listed buildings nearby such as St George's Church, Bedford Square, and the British Museum. Furthermore demolition of the existing block is contrary to the climate change policies of the UK.

Our building, Queen Alexandra Mansions, would be severely overlooked and we would lose much of our daylight. Our flat would never be the same again.

Putting a taller building on the site will set a precedent for more taller buildings in the neighbourhood.
