

Operational Maintenance

3D Eye – production

- 3D Eye are responsible for all aspects of the technical specifications of the gorilla sculptures, including in respect of the durability and lifetime of the gorilla sculptures, as well as the concept and design of the gorilla sculptures
- Prior to delivery to the premises 3D Eye shall carry out a full test of the gorilla sculptures and ensure that all Subcontractors and suppliers have the necessary safety documentation required to install the gorilla sculptures in accordance with industry standards

Install

- Emily Buswell (Brand Partnerships Manager) and appointed IFM (Health & Safety Manager) to be on site for installs to ensure sculptures are installed safely and in the correct locations

Maintenance

- Daily inspections of sculptures on walk-rounds of the estate to check each sculpture is okay
- Damage to the sculptures will be reported straight away to Emily Buswell (Brand Partnerships Manager) and Emily Stroud (Senior Marketing Manager) and reviewed/acted upon on a case-by-case basis
- Any graffiti/removable damage to the sculptures will be taken care of by Chris Westbrook the curator of the trail once reported as above
- Cleaning of the sculptures will be done on an ad-hoc basis when required by the Shaftesbury Capital appointed cleaning team
- Ropes and posts will not be used unless there is unwanted interaction with the sculptures
- Please do not touch/climb signs are placed on each sculpture
- Locations will be re-looked at if required and sculptures are damaged/tampered with
