Its fine Acer has provided a living screen between these two houses since I have lived in Princess Road. This tree -- like the Mimosa next door (T2) -- are home to all sorts of birds and insects; they substantially improve our air quality, provide a calm atmosphere free from pollution and traffic noise, create a cooling effect that helps combat global warming, and afford significant privacy to nearby residents by preventing overlooking.</p> <p>It is hard to imagine that trees can be got rid of so lightly, without any discussion among neighbours who share a rare resource between two rows of Victorian terraced houses.</p> <p>I understand that by regular pruning of upper branches, tree roots can be maintained at a level that does not impact building foundations. Indeed, sudden removal of an entire tree can be just as problematic.</p> <p>I would equally object to the felling of the Mimosa (T2) were that to be suggested, for the same reasons, in the interest of our own local environment.</p> <p>Should, regardless of these objections, either tree be felled, I require that it be replaced by a new tree suitable to the size of the garden.</p>
