Please accept this message as an objection to the proposed development of the Drury Works project and my complete support for the core objections to the project already registered by the Friends of Parker Street (attached).

As a tenant of Flat 5 Market House, my terrace will directly be impacted by significant noise during construction and after the completion of the second floor terrace. As a building, we already deal with significant noise during the evenings and all day on weekends from Barrio and the Gillian Lynne theater across the street. The prospect of additional street noise emanating from the additional occupants of the Drury Works building as well as the noise from the proposed terrace is also concerning. The rear of the building, where the bedroom is located, is already the only room in the flat not severely impacted by the loud street noise. The addition of the Drury Works' terrace will disturb what is the only quiet portion of the flat, with deleterious impact to both my work and ability to find quiet space in the center of London. I am also deeply concerned by the reduction in natural light into the flat that the proposed development will cause. The continued building-up of the area and reduced sunlight not only to my flat but to the lower floors and shared courtyard is of significant concern as well. The added upper floors would serve to further shade and darken the living areas. The combined increase in noise and reduction in sunlight would significantly reduce quality of living for the flat and as such I object to the proposed works in the strongest terms.
