Dear Camden,

I note that you have revised the plan for removal of trees and pruning of trees on Maygrove Walk / Maygrove Wilderness walk. I have some concerns I wish to raise before the devastation of the natural life of this protected stretch of land.

I note that you are not taking comments, but have given this address to write with any further points of concern.

Looking at your map of trees to be culled/pruned, I note the following:

Tree 15 is not in fact touching the new development building and therefore does not need pruning

Tree 17 does not need such excessive pruning

Tree 18 is not obstructing the pavement path and does not need pruning

Tree 20 - agreed

Tree 21 is not touching the building and therefore does not need pruning

Tree 23 - agreed

Tree 29 - agreed

Tree 33 - tree is not touching the building and therefore does not need pruning

Tree 37 - agreed

Tree 42 - agreed

Tree 44 - does not overhang the pavement path and does not need pruning

Tree 46 - does not touch the new development building and does not need pruning

However the tree on the pavement opposite 160 Maygrove Road does need attention and pruning, but is not included in your plan.
