As a summary:  - The hip-to-gable was accepted in principle as it meets the Council's policies and has precedent on the same street.  - The rear dormer was also accepted in principle, but must be reduced to be subservient to the host property. (We have reduced the size).  - The front roof lights (velux) were deemed too large, so must be reduced. (We have reduced the size and quantity to one roof light).  - The rear glazing was deemed too large, so must be reduced.
