I object to to part of these tree works due to the proposed trees numbered 17,18,23,44, as I see no justification that these trees are obstructing the foot path, if that was the case then that would mean all trees within the borough are obstructing footpaths, including trees that are next to curbside of roads, I live opposite the Maygrove bank next to the Liddle rd development and feel this is developer is wanting these trees pruned to enable a better view from these flats.

We were informed at the early stages of the original planning that these trees would shelter our homes from the development, Myself and other residents have have also studied your proposals and justification on the trees numbered 15,

21,26,46 that says the branches are touching the buildings that are not touching the building, these trees over this last year have already been pruned by the developer without permission when they erected the scaffolding which were left on the the bank and are still there, and I object to these works.

I would also believe that the tree 15 on the footpath opposite number 160 Maygrove rd does need attention due to the overhang over the road, Although it's not part of these works it seems strange that the tree department has not observed this overhang that could damage parked/passing cars in the future,
