We strongly object to felling the two trees mentioned in this application.

We've lived at 25A Swains Lane for 14 years, from where these trees are visible. Our conservation area is famed for being leafy and beautiful. These two trees are home to local birds, among which, blue tits, long tailed tits, finches, parakeets, robins, and at least one woodpecker. Like every other tree in the area they filter and recycle the air, offsetting traffic emissions on the busy Lane and Highgate road.

Both trees appear to be healthy? Their branches don't seem to be touching or putting any pressure against the adjacent roof. The trunk of one of them appears to be growing around the roof. We could not identify any cracks on the photos provided.

Surely pruning these trees resolves exactly the problem presented in the application?
