I OBJECT TO THIS TERRIBLE AND HARMFUL PLANNING APPLICATION.

Dear Planning Officers,

I have lived within 250 metres of One Museum Street for 17 years and have brought my children up here. I work even closer!

I am writing to lodge my objections to the development planned at One Museum Street.

1. Knocking down a building that could be repurposed is disgraceful in this historic and residential area. The extra pollution and years of disruption for the people living and working here should be avoided at all costs. This application is against Camden's Climate Change Mitigation Policies, which really should be a priority over yet another unneeded office project.
2. The latest version of the planning application still has an inappropriately large tower planned, which will loom over the beautiful small buildings in the conservation areas around it and set a precedent for future developments, which could change the nature of this beautiful and surprisingly peaceful area for ever.
3. There is not enough genuinely affordable housing planned for local families and young people starting out. The plans include demolishing more housing than it will include once completed so is actually taking housing away from the local community.
4. It will do irreparable harm to the conservation areas of Bloomsbury, Seven Dials and Soho.
