Subject: Objection to the Proposal at One Museum Street

Dear Sir/Madam,

As a frequent visitor to London, and having had the privilege of staying round the corner from the British Museum on numerous occasions, I must register my objection to the proposed (revised) scheme at One Museum Street. This project displays scorn for the esthetics and harmony of the surrounding buildings and seems completely inappropriate in this context. Furthermore the development will set a precedent for more taller buildings in the neighbourhood, which is certainly not a desirable outcome, either for nearby residents or for the attractiveness of the area. As a British national living in Paris, I cannot believe that this project would receive planning permission in this city, where the historic and esthetic context is strictly respected and the construction of new high-rise buildings has, in the last fifty years, - with very few high-profile exceptions like the Pompidou Centre - been limited specifically to the more modern quarters of the city (e.g. the 13th or 17th "arrondissements").
