I wish to object to this planning application on the following grounds:

- The proposed tower is too tall and too bulky for this location.
- It will have an adverse impact on the listed buildings nearby eg St. George's Church Bedford Square, and the British Museum.
- It will adversely affect the local Conservation Areas of Covent Garden, Bloomsbury and Soho.
- The scale of the tower is much greater than the existing one, and would create a precedent for larger taller buildings in the area.

Although I do not live in the neighbourhood, I regularly walk through this area from Euston Station to the British Museum and Oxford St.
